"AN ENORMOUSLY SUCCESSFUL YEAR"

At the end of my first year as board chair, I am reflecting on what has been an enormously successful year at West Coast LEAF. The highlights are many and set the stage for much anticipated growth of the organization.

This year, West Coast LEAF's litigation efforts included intervening in cases to challenge mandatory minimum sentences, protect women's right to safe health care, resist harmful myths and stereotypes about sexual

assault, and ensure the legal profession remains equally accessible to all, regardless of sexual orientation, marital status, or sex. We ended the year with a formidable development in our litigation program, filling our new position of Director of Litigation. This addition allows us to identify systemic issues and bring forward test case litigation, a significant expansion of our capacity.

Though it can take years to see the effects of law reform work, this year we witnessed results of our 2014 call to the Residential Tenancy Branch to help keep women safe. Earlier this year, provincial legislation was amended to allow tenants fleeing family violence to end fixed-term tenancies without penalty, a significant win for women in our province. We also saw the implementation of some of the recommendations from our co-authored 2012 report *Blueprint for an Inquiry* in the terms of reference for the National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls.

This year, we reached more than 2,300 youth in the Lower Mainland, Nanaimo, and for the first time in Kamloops, where we have a new dedicated youth facilitator. As well, we worked and consulted with older women and began developing new resources for older women escaping abuse.

West Coast LEAF has provided media commentary on women's equality issues for years and this year we did a record number of interviews. Even still, the *Georgia Straight* called women's equality one of the most underreported stories of 2015. West Coast LEAF is making sure the same can't be said in 2016. We've increased our outreach to all forms of media to help get the word out about equality issues.

Last but not least, we carefully laid the groundwork for what has become Rise Women's Legal Centre. This partnership with UBC's Allard School of Law required tremendous commitments from staff and from the community, including many of you. This has been a testament to what can happen when we work together on addressing a clear and pressing need for women.

With the foundation we've built over the last 31 years and the significant building blocks put in place this past year, I know we will continue to see our efforts succeed. Thank you for your commitment to advancing women's equality and towards building a more equal BC.
